Luncheon Held For Feminist Of Costa Rica

Senora Angela Acuna de Chacon of Costa Rica, who is making a study of the juvenile court system in the United States, was honored at a luncheon yesterday by Miss Mabel Vernon, director of the Peoples Mandate Committee, at the clubhouse of the American Association of University Women.

Representatives of women's service clubs in Washington were invited to meet Senora de Chacon who is the Peoples Mandate chairman in Costa Rica. Work of the Peoples Mandate Committee for inter-American peace and cooperation was discussed informally at the luncheon.

Senora de Chacon was a member of the Latin-American delegation which made a good-will tour in this country last year under Mandate auspices. Women's service clubs were on the sponsors' committee for the tour.

Senora de Chacon was instrumental in the recent passage of a law in Costa Rica giving women the right to be juvenile court judges. She will remain in Washington for a month, and then go to New York and Denver to observe the juvenile courts in those cities.

Invited to Miss Vernon's luncheon were Mrs. Jean Bennett, national president of the American Federation of Soroptimist Clubs; Miss Owlady Jones, general secretary of Quota Club International; Dr. Florence Armstrong, of the Federation of Business and Professional Women's Clubs; Dr. Edith Seville Coale, of Zonta International, and Miss Nora Beust, of the Altrua Club.
